

CLASS X ENGLISH COURSE BOOK LESSON 2 - A TRIP TO DZUKO VALLEY

NOTES

- 1. An eighteen member team went for a trekking expedition to **Dzuko** Valley.
- 2. The valley is located at an altitude of 2450 metres above mean sea level.
- 3. The valley is amphitheatre-like.
- It is surrounded by *Mt. Japfu* Peak on the north-west and *Mt. Iso* Peak (*Mt. Tempu*) on the south-east.
- 5. Temperature plummeted to -20° C in the early morning and afterwards ranges between 6° C and 18° C.
- 6. Dzuko is derived from the Mao tribe words- *Dzu* meaning 'water' and *Ko* meaning 'cold'.
- 7. As one stands in the valley, the view one gets is truly amazing.
- 8. The lasting beauty of the place depends on 'Man'.
