NOTES:

Resource means anything which is available for use by man and satisfies his Resource needs.

Type of resources:

i. Natural Resources-

> Natural resources are those resources provided by nature including air, water, soil, natural vegetation, all creatures including man and the rocks and minerals.

ii. Human Resources-

> Human resources refer to skilled people who could use their skills, knowledge and experience for various productive or creative activities, e.g. scientist, teacher etc.

Cultural Resourcesiii.

> All the productive and creative activities of man along with their skills, talents, ideas, knowledge, thoughts, and beliefs are called cultural resources.

Resources of Manipur-

Manipur is rich in natural resources. Besides these, Manipur has a lot of potential for human resources. We need to focus on education to draw out these potentials and develop our human resources. Manipur is rich in cultural resources too. Manipuri dance, theatre and sporting talent are known all over the world.
