

Chapter 2:

Whole Numbers

- 1. The counting numbers 1,2,3,4,5.... are called natural numbers.
- 2. If zero is included in the collection of natural numbers. The new collection 0,1,2,3,4,5....becomes the collection of whole numbers.
- 3. Every natural number has a successor. Every natural number (except 1) has a predecessor.
- 4. Every whole number has a successor. Every whole number (except 0) has a predecessor.
- 5. All natural numbers are whole numbers but all whole numbers are not natural number (since 0 is not a natural number).
