After the game, there was a wrestling match called "Mukna", and Nongban had been undefeated for 7 years. In this game also, the unknown man defeated Nongban and became the new champion. The news of the defeat of Nongban reached the house of minister. He called the young man and asked his name to which the man replied that he was a very poor man and has no name. The minister was angry and about to punish him but a young beautiful woman came running and fell on her knees before the minister not to punish him, who was her brother. She told the minister that his name was Khamba and she was Khamnu. They were orphan and their parents were Puremba and Ngangkhareima.
