

CLASS IX DISASTER MANAGEMENT UNIT V CHAPTER 2 COMPONENTS OF DISASTER MANAGEMENT

NOTES

- Four elements or components of emergency disaster management are generally recognized as, (i) Preparedness, (ii) Response, (iii) Recovery, and (iv) Prevention/Planning. (PRRP).
- Preparedness It means the measures to ensure that communities and services are capable of coping with the effect of disaster.
- ➤ Response It means the measures taken during and immediately after a disaster to ensure that the effects are minimized.
- Recovery It means the measures which support affected communities in the construction of physical infrastructure, economic and emotional well being.
- **Prevention/Planning** It means the measures to reduce the severity of disaster.
- There has been a shift in emphasis from 'disaster response and recovery' to 'disaster risk management and risk reduction', strategies and from 'Government-centered approach' to 'community participation'.
- Disaster management is actually a series of activities that run parallel to one another rather than in a sequence of pre and post disaster activities.
- ➤ It is something like an **EXPAND AND CONTRACT model** as it can be carried out at all times on the basis of hazard and vulnerability of the community concerned.
