NOTES

- The aim of community planning is to reduce the vulnerability and increase the capacities of the individuals and the community to cope with the damaging effects of disasters.
- 'First responders' are people who are first to act as a response to a disaster.
- Trained community members are life-saving assets in such situations.
- The Government of India strongly advocates communities to develop disaster management plans to prevent, mitigate and prepare better for disasters.
- It also sees a prime role for teachers and students as educated members of the community in planning to reduce disaster risks.
- Indian is traditionally a community based society.
- We must rebuild our links with community and learn to act together as a team to reduce vulnerability.
- Community acts as the First Responder.
- It is the source of maximum information regarding the people living there.
- Community traditionally has the local coping mechanism that is handed down over the generations.
- Its self-help is in self-interest because dependence on external help may be time-consuming and EDUCATION even ineffective.
- In school, a Disaster Management Committee is to be constituted.
