- a. Mysteries which are difficult to explain happen in the world.
- **b.** One such inexplicable mystery surrounds the invasion of *Japan* by the *Mongols*.
- c. The *Mongols* under *Emperor Kublai Khan* invaded *Japan* twice but in both he had to retreat.
- **d.** During both the invasions, a *Divine Wind* in the form of a ferocious typhoon came to the rescue of *Japan*, a weak side.
- e. The formidable *Mongol* army could not capture *Japan* twice.
- f. The typhoons which wrecked the *Mongol* fleet twice were mysterious because typhoons hardly strike *Hakata Bay* of *Japan* where the *Mongols* established their beachhead.
- g. Also the timing of the typhoons was not right. So we can conclude that there was divine intervention when the *Mongols* invaded *Japan*.
